This is with reference to school application on the subject cited above. I am directed to convey the approval of the Board for Affiliation i.e Upgradation to Senior Secondary Level as per details given below :

Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of sections shall be restricted to 17 , of which not more than 1/3rd sections may be used for senior secondary classes.Number of students in class rooms of <500 ft shall be restricted to 32.Any further increase shall require prior approval of the Board and shall be subject to compliance with affiliation byelaws and availability of rooms of >500 ft size.
2	The School shall appoint a wellness teacher and counselor within 3months and submit compliance on SARAS with appointment letter and qualification details.

3	CWSN toilets for boys and girls are seen only on ground floor.they dont have proper signage.Regular cubicles have been converted into CWSN toilets which are too small for a wheelchair to enter and navigate, as is evident in the video.The school shall construct separate toilets for CWSN, boys and girls on every floor with proper permanent signage a, as per norms of RPwD Act and guidelines issued by the Board within 3months and submit compliance on SARAS with videography.
4	The school shall level the entry point of ramp to access the upper floors to facilitate navigation by CWSN within 3months and submit compliance on SARAS with videography.
5	The school shall increase the number of computers to a minimum of 40as per the latest directions of the Board and replace the wooden desks by comfortable computer chairs for students within 3months and submit compliance on SARAS with videography..
6	The Computer Lab is under stocked. The School should have a minimum of 20 computers and maintain computer to student ratio of 1:20.
7	The school boundary wall has steel grills in the front, which is not as per bye laws.The school shall construct a concrete boundary wall of 6 ft height in its place within 3months and submit compliance on SARAS with videography.
8	The school shall add more books and periodicals and magazines for senior secondary students and upgrade the library as per SoP issued by the Board within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAs with videography.
9	The School shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Chandigarh within 3months and submit compliance on SARAS.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/ Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to

regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.

5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted with in the stipulated 3 months , the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
